GM Believes:

- The University has a commitment to reasonably safeguard students within Halls.
- That this security problem also leads to Bullying behaviour amongst some students.
- Students should be safe and other people should not be able to access their room.

GM Resolves:

- Lobby the university to change locks in Penbryn to protect student safety.
- Mandate the Education and Welfare Officer to specifically highlight safety issues within the Penbryn Halls.
- Mandate the President to report the results of the lobbying at the next General Meeting.
