

Schedule 7 to the Democracy Referendum Proposal

1. Enact a new Regulation 7 as follows:

REGULATION 7 BLOCK OF 15

SELECTION

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The membership of the Block of 15 shall be filled by a random selection ("selection").
- 1.2 A selection shall be made at least five clear days prior to every Meeting.

2. Candidacy

- 2.1 A person may only be selected as a member of the Block of 15 ("Block member") if they are an AUGS Member at the time the selection is made.
- 2.2 Notwithstanding section 2.1, the selection of a person as a Block member shall be invalid if that person:
 - (a) has previously been selected as a Block member at any time whatsoever,
 - (b) is otherwise an Assembly Member, or
 - (c) is a Trustee of AUGS.

3. Selection

- 3.1 The selection shall be carried out by means of a computer programme which selects student numbers at random.
- 3.2 The programme shall be caused to select 15 student numbers for every selection, but where a selection of a person is invalid by virtue of section 2.2, a new selection shall be made in respect of that person.
- 3.3 Every person whose student number is selected (and whose selection is not invalid) shall be a Block member.
- 3.4 The Returning Officer shall make available upon the request of any AUGS Member the code of a programme used for the purposes of a selection.

4. Announcement of Block members

- 4.1 The Returning Officer must notify every Block member of his selection as soon as is reasonably practicable after that selection, and in any case within 24 hours of that time.
- 4.2 The Returning Officer must:
 - (a) publish the name of every candidate who has been elected, and
 - (b) notify the same to the Guild Chairperson;in writing as soon as is reasonably practicable after the count, and in any case within twenty-four hours of that time.

GENERAL

6. Period of office

- 6.1 A person shall cease to be a Block member if he:
- (a) resigns as a Block member,
 - (b) ceases to be an AUGS Member, or
 - (c) dies.
- 6.2 In every other case, a person shall cease to be a Block member at the end of the Meeting for which they were selected.

7. Resignation

- 7.1 A person may resign as a Block member in writing to the Guild Chairperson. Such a resignation shall have effect from the day and time at which it is received by the Guild Chairperson.

MISCELLANEOUS

8. Interpretation

- 8.1 A requirement imposed by this Regulation upon any person to publish any document or notice shall be construed as a requirement to make that document or notice available:
- (a) in a physical medium in the Guild Building,
 - (b) on the AUGS website, and
 - (c) on the request of an AUGS Member.
- 8.2 In this regulation, the following meanings shall have effect:
- “AUGS Member” shall have the meaning given to “Member” by clause 15 of the Constitution,
 - “student number” means the number assigned to every student by Aberystwyth University as their student number.
